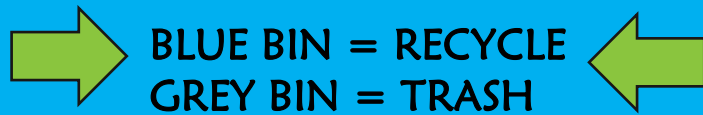

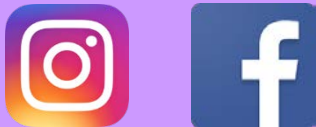

- Place all accessories (hair pieces, gloves, belts, etc.) into a zip-lock baggie hooked through your hanger
- Do not let your child play in their recital costumes until AFTER June 1, 2019.
