Dress rehearsal week is a fun week where we all head to the blue room & share our recital dances with each other in FULL costume as a final rehearsal before recitals!

A note from our photographer ...

Hey Parents! I am so excited to see everyone again this year for Recital portraits. Recital packages (same dance) start at \$26 and "Build your own packages" start at \$28. For those dancers in multiple dances, you will be able to order individuals of each dance and "build" your own package from multiple dances. We will have Bag Tags, Key Chains, Statuettes, Memory Mates (these have a photo of your child AND the class photo as well) and porcelain Christmas Tree Ornaments. I will have samples during picture days for you to see. For those sending checks with your kiddos, we do add tax (7%) so please be sure to add that or leave blank for total when paying at checkout. 4. Pre-register your child(ren) for next year's dance classes!



Who should pre-register?

ALL returning students, ages 3 and up.

Why is it so important to pre-register?

Pre-registration forms help us know which classes to offer next year, and on which days to schedule them so they hopefully work with YOUR schedule.

Plus, you SAVE \$15 per child if you pre-register before May 31!!

Where can I find a pre-registration form?

Forms are available in this newsletter (pg. 6) and at the BFA front desk.

Where do I turn in my pre-registration form?

Return form to the BFA front desk accompanied by your payment of \$25.

3. Have your dancer in full recital garb (costume, hair, makeup, accessories) and warmed up 15 minutes prior to their usual class time. This will be a HUGE help in keeping this crazy week on schedule.

Nothing helps set a dancer in a tizzy like being late to a rehearsal or having last minute fixes to tend to. If you have never been through a recital dress rehearsal before, prepare yourself for a crowded studio. With parents, costumes, and photographers personal space can run a bit short. Be sure to get ready as much as you can AT HOME so all your dancer needs to do is change shoes and warm up upon arriving at the studio.

2. Ask questions so you are sure you know what's going on.

Remember, this is your last chance for you and your dancer to get out any last minute pre-recital jitters. If you have any questions, please ask your child's teacher or the front desk receptionist.

1. Stay flexible!

Though this week is exciting, it can be a little crazy for students, parents, and staff. Go ahead and prepare yourself to arrive a little earlier than your child's class and possibly leave a little later than your child's class typically ends. Your child's class will run their dance at least twice in the blue room and take a group photo in the purple room. If you bring your child fully ready, our staff will take it from there and work on getting everyone in and out in an orderly fashion

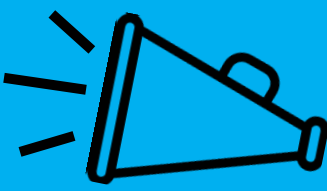
